

Requirements for PAK visas

Category 1: Single Entry Tourist Visa

The following documents are mandatory for your Visa Application.

- 1: Letter by Sponsor/Hotel – Letter by Operator (Recog. by Dept. Of Tourist Services)
- 2: Passport
- 3: Photograph
- 4: Sponsor's Pakistani CNIC

FEE: 25 USD

Category 1: Business Individual Visa

The following documents are mandatory for your Visa Application.

- 1: Letter by Sponsor/Hotel – Letter by Operator (Recog. by Dept. Of Tourist Services)
- 2: Passport
- 3: Photograph
- 4: E-BIL Business Invitation Letter
- 5: Sponsor Company's Bank Statement, Account Maintenance Certificate, Chamber of commerce's Certificate.
- 6: Sponsor's Pakistani CNIC

FEE: 100 USD

Category 1: Study Visa

The following documents are mandatory for your Visa Application. (Study Visa)

- 1: Admission/Bonafide Letter
- 2: For Entry Visa: NOC from Home Department of the Student
- 3: NOC from HEC/EAD/IPC/Health Ministry/Education Ministry
- 4: NOC from the Concerned Embassy
- 5: Sponsorship/Bank Statement In Case Of Accompanying Family
- 6: Passport
- 7: Photograph

FEE: 50 USD

Conditions

1. The period of validity of the travel document should be 6 months longer than expire date of the e-visa to be issued.
2. The e-visa is issued within 4 – 6 weeks.
3. In case of submission of false or incomplete information or incorrect realization of payments, an electronic visa application is not accepted.
4. In case of rejection to issue an e-visa, foreigners and stateless persons may re-apply for a visa.
5. No refund will be granted for payments in case of electronic visa rejection.
6. An electronic visa is not attached in a passport. An e-Visa should be printed out by a foreigner or a stateless person and presented together with a travel document at a border checkpoint.
7. An electronic visa is an initial document permitting entry into and travel within the Islamic Republic of Pakistan. Entry may be prohibited in cases specified in the Migration Code of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan.
8. The electronic visa becomes invalid if it is not used within the period of its validity.
9. Foreigners and stateless persons trying to cross the border with forged documents or with documents belonging to other persons will be held liable as provided for by the law.
